Sabra E. Horne '87

Sabra Horne is the director of the Organizational Change Management Initiative, overseeing the transformation of the Department of Homeland Security (DHS) Cybersecurity and Infrastructure Agency into a component agency. She previously was the director of Stakeholder Engagement and Cyber Infrastructure Resilience, leading agency efforts for ensuring the effective sharing of cyber information with the private sector, as well as state, local, tribal and territorial entities. Prior to her time at DHS, she served at the National Security Agency (NSA) as the deputy chief for information sharing and collaboration, facilitating the sharing of the NSA's most highly classified intelligence. She was senior advisor to NSA Threat Operations Center leadership and led its effort to share unclassified cyber threat information with other government agencies and the private sector. Horne was previously director of communications at the Department of Justice Office of Justice Programs,

responsible for all legislative, public and intergovernmental affairs, and senior advisor for strategic partnerships for open source at the Office of the Director of National Intelligence, where she also served as the chief of staff in the standup of the National Maritime Intelligence Center and lead development of the Unified Intelligence Strategy for the National Intelligence Manager for Cyber. Prior to her government service, she had an 18-year career in academic publishing, the last 12 as senior executive editor for the largest list of academic criminal justice publications at Wadsworth Publishing. Horne holds a master's degree in public administration from the Harvard Kennedy School of Government and a bachelor of arts degree in English from the College of Charleston. She is a member of the College of Charleston School of Humanities and Social Sciences Dean's Council. Horne and her husband, John, live in Washington, D.C.

HONORARY DEGREE RECIPIENTS

Carolyn Feinberg Draisin

Retired teacher Carolyn Feinberg Draisin taught elementary school children in three states over the course of her more than 20-year career as an educator. Draisin was born and raised in Opelika, Ala., where her parents, Sidney and Francis Feinberg, instilled in her and her siblings a great appreciation for education and respect for educators. After graduating from the University of Alabama with a bachelor of science degree in education, Draisin taught elementary school children in Atlanta, Ga., for three years. She then moved to Pennsylvania, where she was a grade school teacher in the Cheltenham Township School District for three years. Relocating to Charleston, she held a teaching position at Orange Grove Elementary Charter School. Her longstanding connection to the College of Charleston began by mentoring student teachers. Growing up in the South during segregation and bearing witness to the fight for civil rights, Draisin aimed at creating a level playing field in the classroom. She not only helped shape future educators, she sought to support her own thirst for professional development with continued education, taking graduate courses at the College of Charleston. Draisin and her husband, Neil, have three children, Alison, Leslie and David.

Neil W. Draisin '65

Dr. Neil W. Draisin is an optometrist who is board certified in children's vision and visual perception and development, as well as the treatment and management of eye disease. An authority in vision therapy and rehabilitation, Draisin has maintained a private practice in Charleston since 1972. He is a fellow and past president of the College of Optometrists and of the South Carolina Optometric Association and past president of the Southeastern Council of Optometrists. He established the Head Start Vision Screening Program in Charleston in 1976. He serves on the College of Charleston Foundation Board of Directors and was elected to the National Academy of Practice in 2011. He was named Alumnus of the Year for the Pennsylvania College of Optometry in 2001, was awarded the American Optometric Association's Optometrist of the Year in 2013 and the American Optometric Association's Optometric Recognition Award for excelling continuing education from 1990 to 2016. Draisin graduated from the College of Charleston with a bachelor of science degree in biology and is a graduate of Pennsylvania College of Optometry. He completed his residency in pediatric optometry and vision therapy at State University of New York.

Gregory Duncan Padgett '97

Gregory Duncan Padgett is the chief financial officer for Fennell Holdings Inc., a Charleston-based investment holding company encompassing the hospitality, waste services, real estate, aviation, security and finance industries. A native of Spartanburg, S.C., he received a bachelor of science degree in business administration from the College of Charleston in 1979 and is a certified public accountant. Padgett's involvement with the College of Charleston has been longstanding and far-reaching, having served on numerous boards. He is a past chair for the College of Charleston Board of Trustees, and for eight years he served in the Trustee seat nominated by the College of Charleston Alumni Association. He is also a past president of the College of Charleston Foundation Board of Directors and a past member of the College of Charleston Cougar Club Board. He currently serves as a member of the College of Charleston School of Business Board of Governors and recently held a seat on the College of Charleston Presidential Search Committee. Padgett resides in Charleston. He and his wife, Tina, have two children, Ryan and Anna. They have three grandchildren, Jack, Sunday and Maria.

COLLEGE OF CHARLESTON SEAL



Sapientia Ipsa Libertas – “Wisdom Itself Is Liberty”
Ædes Mores Juraque Curat – “She Cares for Her Temples, Customs and Rights”

In 1783, the City of Charleston adopted its official seal. It features a seated woman holding a scepter pointing toward the mouth of the harbor. The city skyline and a sailing vessel making for port are in the background; the motto *Ædes Mores Juraque Curat* surrounds the image. Traditionally, the woman portrayed in the seal is described as a personification of Charleston itself, and evokes an image of a city that derives its livelihood from the sea and is prepared to defend itself.

The College of Charleston seal is an adaptation of the city seal and was approved by the Board of Trustees in 1843. The phrase *Sapientia Ipsa Libertas* and the image of a young man holding a diploma were added to the College seal; the original, 19th-century Main Building (today's Randolph Hall) is in the background. The seated woman is presenting a laurel wreath to the young man (the City of Charleston incorporated the laurel wreath into its seal early in the 20th century).

GRADUATION WITH HONORS

Students who earn a grade point average (GPA) of 3.900 to 4.000 will graduate *Summa Cum Laude*. Students who earn a GPA of 3.750 to 3.899 will graduate *Magna Cum Laude*. Students who earn a GPA of 3.500 to 3.749 will graduate *Cum Laude*. To be eligible for graduation with honors, at least 62 hours of the coursework to be applied to the degree must have been performed at the College of Charleston. These honor graduates are wearing a maroon ribbon and medallion. Members of the honor society *Phi Kappa Phi* can be recognized by the blue ribbon and medallion each is wearing. Members of the Golden Key International Honor Society can be recognized by the blue and gold cord each is wearing. Members of the honor society *Phi Eta Sigma* can be recognized by the black and gold cord or medallion each is wearing. Please note that student honors in the printed program are presumptive, reflecting academic achievement through August 2018. Official honors will be awarded once final grades have been computed, and they will be recognized on the diploma and transcript.
